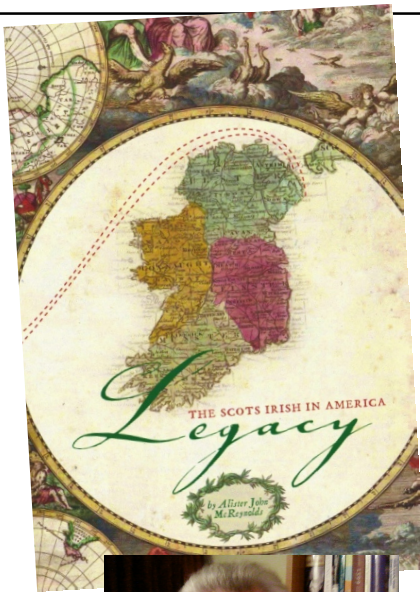

Alister McReynolds traces the achievements of the Scots Irish in America in his new book, *Legacy*. A Principal and Chief Executive of Lisburn Institute of Further and Higher Education, McReynolds tells the story of these ordinary, yet somehow remarkable individuals in a lively and human fashion. The people portrayed, including Garden City's founder Alexander Turney Stewart, possessed a kind of inventiveness and energy that literally "moved mountains." *Legacy* focuses on states and characters that up to now have been somewhat overlooked and speaks of the saga of the tough Scots Irish who protected, settled and built American landscapes from Maine to southern Georgia.

(Lisburn is the birthplace of A.T. Stewart.)
